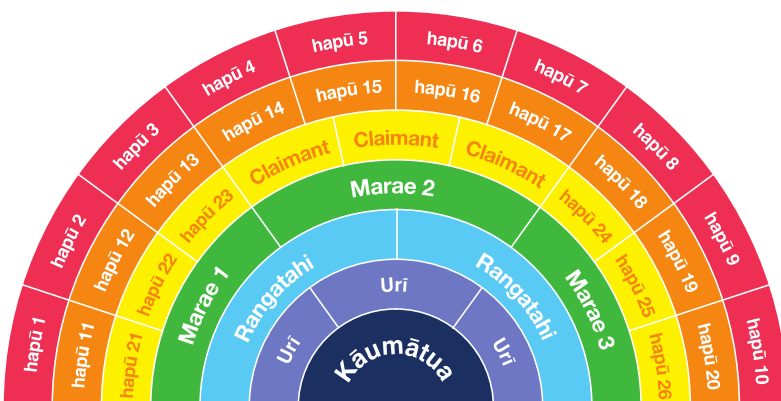

Uenuku Charitable Trust proposed mandate

Uenuku Charitable Trust (UCT) is seeking a mandate from the Te Korowai o Wainuiarua claimant community to enter into negotiations with the Crown on their behalf for the comprehensive settlement of all historical Treaty of Waitangi claims that relate to the central Whanganui Large Natural Group (LNG).

The Te Korowai o Wainuiarua rohe comprises whānau who descend from Tūpuna from the mountain to the sea.

UCT seeks to secure a settlement for all descendants of Te Korowai o Wainuiarua that:

- Addresses all grievances with appropriate apologies, acknowledgements and redress.
- Is fair and durable.
- Provides a basis for whānau, hapū, iwi development.

Who is Uenuku Charitable Trust?

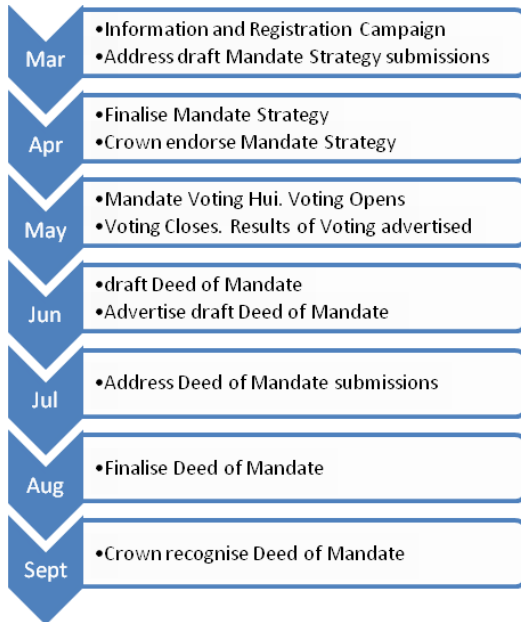
UCT was registered in April 2014 as part of the work to prepare for Treaty settlements. It was established following a series of Hui-ā-iwi with a view to providing a structure where all voices in the central Whanganui region could be heard.

UCT has a large Board of Trustees including seats for Hapū, Marae, Wai claimants, uri, rangatahi and kaumātua as of right in order to be fully inclusive and representative. The intention is that UCT represents all sections of the Te Korowai o Wainuiarua claimant community in the central Whanganui region and throughout Aotearoa.

We seek to agree a positive way forward while recognising that there will always be room for differing views. We are constantly evolving our policies to recognise the growth in representation and participation across Te Korowai o Wainuiarua. We seek to work together to strengthen our collective voice and, as is your right, welcome your participation and contribution.
